FARMERS' CONGRESS REPORT

September 15, 2015

San Mateo, Isabela

2015 Farmers' Congress cum medical and Dental Mission was held at The New Community Center of San Mateo, Isabela. Upon the arrival of the Isabela Provincial Government employee, around 7:30 AM, the event was opened to all participants coming from the 33 Barangay covering the whole San Mateo, Isabela. Around 7:40 am, when the couple, Mayor Crispina R. Agcaoili and Vice Mayor Roberto C. Agcaoili together with the LGU of San Mateo arrived in the venue. The ENRO Personnel opened the table for the distribution of seedlings and fertilizers.

9:00 am, Hon. Agosto B. Gamboa started the program, opening prayer was led by Mr. Emiliano P. Camba, Municipal Agriculturist, followed by the singing of National Anthem, Isabela Hymn and San Mateo Hymn conducted by Ms. Jeremy G. Yanos together with LGU Choir, the lead singers. Subsequently, Provincial information officer, Mr. John Soriano, Acknowledged the different focal persons heading the different programs of the province namely, starting from Agriculture (BROs ASP, PPP, PSP, LAMFP, PAIWI and livelihood); Health (BROs Healthcare & PhilHealth); Insurance (BROs PNB Gen & SSS); Scholarship (BRO Education) for their children and Nutrition (BRO Lusog) the new service to combat malnutrition in which Dr. Betina Cabrera stresses out.

About an hour later, Gov. Faustino Bojie G. Dy, III and Vice Governor Antonio Tonyt T. Albano finally arrived in the said event, assisted by Mayor and Vice Mayor Agcaoili with the LGU San Mateo. Hon. Roberto C. Agcaoili, delivered his welcome address, followed by the opening remarks of Mayor Crispina R. Agcaoili. After which, Vice Governor Antonio Tonyt T. Albano turn, he was impressed in the governance, the way Mayor Agcaoili lead the town of San Mateo, making it to bagged as the one of the best town in terms of governance. Vice Governor Albano mentioned also about the cash allowance to be given per Barangay which is 150 thousand, and the people of the province and the province itself for being ready in all types' phenomenon and crisis. Consequently, Gov. Faustino Bojie Dy, III, finally delivered his speech in which he bring up about Cash Assistants to farmers, Additional funds for National food Authority, and price for the products of farmers. Thereafter was awarding of cash on financial assistance to Bro-SSS to the beneficiaries of San Mateo

After the opening ceremony, BRO LAMFP orientation and forum headed by the following department: OPA, PCDO, Healthcare, PhilHealth, PVET, BRO Educ, SSS, Life Insurance, IPHO and BRO LUSOG, BRO PAG-IBIG, PLO. Last part of the program is the Medical and Dental and Public Assistance Desk.

The ENR Office was able to serve **Two-hundred seventy (270)** clientele from 33 Barangay and disposed a total of **Two-hundred fifty (250) assorted fruit bearing seedlings** and **20 packs of fertilizer** to wit:
