- Production/Propagation and Disposition of seedlings	Production, propagation and procurement of seedling stock and disposition of seedlings	No. of seedlings produced/propagated = <b>688 forest and fruit tree seedlings</b> - 83 Cacao, 305 Duhat and 300 Tindalo seedlings; A total of 570 seedlings were disposed for this month specifically 100 fruit-bearing tree seedlings, 200 Bamboo propagules and 270 forest tree seedlings.
- Maintenance works	Maintenance of Provincial Nursery; Operation of Clonal Nursery; Brushing, ring weeding and greening of two nurseries; arrangement, and sorting of seedlings for hardening; seed collection and propagation; and other activities that may be assigned	ENRO personel and the 6 hired laborers (Job Order) conducted the maintenance and operation of Provincial and Clonal nurseries. <b>C. Other Related Activities</b>		
1. Conduct of Certificate of Stewardship Contract (CSC) Holders' Evaluation and Assessment	In partnership with personnel from DENR-CENRO Naguilian, Isabela, conducted evaluation and performance assessment of CSC holders to verify the status of development they have introduced in their respective farmlots within portions of the forest zones under the Integrated Social Forestry (ISF) Project. Results of the evaluation will be the basis in coming up with common recommendations whether to cancel or renew their contracts.	The TWG/Evaluation Team composed of representatives from the DENR and provincial, city and barangay LGUs conducted the CSC evaluation and field assessment within the ISF Project located at Barangays Gayong-Gayong Sur and Salindigan in the City of Ilagan, Isabela. The targeted CSC holders to be evaluated individually is 75 for the whole year and the team was able to accomplished 16 farmer-beneficiaries as of this month and 3 ISF Holders were renewed for another 25 years.






Accreditation of Haulers</p>	<p>The ENR Office is responsible in field verification and evaluation of quarry area to determine compliance of permit holders/haulers to environmental laws, rules and regulations. Also, regular monitoring of extraction of sand and gravel and other quarry resources is conducted which shall serve as basis for the collection of taxes and other related fees by the Provincial Treasurer's Office.</p>	<p>For this month, a total of One (1) haulers/dealers/traders and retailers in trading mineral products and by-products were accredited with corresponding fees collected by the PTO amounting to Two Thousand Five Hundred Twenty (Php2,520.00) pesos and Two Hundred (Php200.00) pesos for Accreditation Sticker.</p>
