

Summary of Waste Disposal:



The weekly summary report highlights the waste generation and disposal activities within the Capitol Compound. Most departments are adhering to waste segregation policies and improved waste management practices. A total of **4,429.43 kilograms** (recyclable, residual, hazardous, and biodegradable) were collected and disposed through the ENRO MRF, Compost Heap and Vermicomposting Facilities, and to the City of Ilagan Sanitary Landfill Facility (SLF).

Status: Not Segregated

Date of visit: July 10, 2024

Findings and Observations:

- They don't have color coded trash bins but properly labeled.
- The hallways were clean.
- Mixed wastes inside the trash bins.
- Some personnel are not aware on proper waste segregation.

Recommendations:

- Conduct brief Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) Campaign regarding on Solid Waste Management most importantly on Waste Segregation.
- Observe proper waste segregation.



MATERIALS RECOVERY FACILITY (MRF) ROUTINE OPERATIONS ON SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT












CAUAYAN DISTRICT HOSPITAL






MANUEL A. ROXAS DISTRICT HOSPITAL








