

As part of the Environment and Natural Resources Office (ENRO) initiative to enforce solid waste management practices within the Provincial Government of Isabela offices, compound establishments, and hospitals, the team conducted random inspection of at least two offices within the week to ensure full compliance with Executive Order No. 28 and Memorandum No. 13, Series of 2024.

On July 26, 2024, the team briefly inspected the Provincial Security Group (PSG) and the Provincial General Services Office (PGSO). Overall, both offices demonstrated strict adherence to proper solid waste segregation practices, labelings per trash bins. However, it is recommended that they implement briefings and orientation with stakeholders to inform and guide them on proper waste segregation.

Summary of Waste Disposal:



The weekly summary report highlights the waste generation and disposal activities within the Capitol Compound. Most departments are adhering to waste segregation policies and improved waste management practices. A total of **4,581.26 kilograms** (recyclable, residual, hazardous, and biodegradable) were collected and disposed through the ENRO MRF, Compost Heap and Vermicomposting Facilities, and to the City of Ilagan Sanitary Landfill Facility (SLF).


Sorting and Segregation of Wastes.
