The weekly summary report highlights the waste generation and disposal activities within the Capitol Compound and Provincially Operated Hospitals. A total of **4,590.61 kilograms** (recyclable, residual, hazardous, and biodegradable) were collected and disposed through the ENRO MRF, Compost Heap and Vermicomposting Facilities, and to the City of Ilagan Sanitary Landfill Facility (SLF).

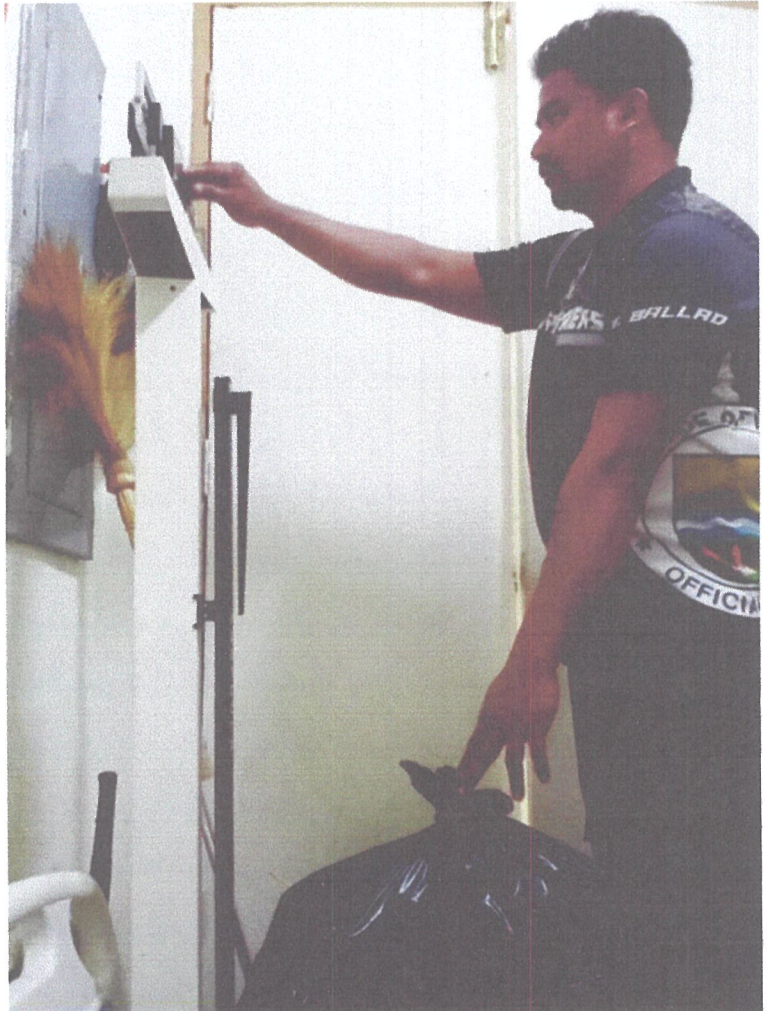
