### Monitoring and Inspection

The solid waste disposal facilities of GFNDy Sr. Memorial Hospital underwent monitoring and inspection on March 13, 2025. The Material Recovery Facility is properly maintained while the Hazardous Storage Area has recently installed entry caution signage to fulfil requirements set by the recent monitoring by the DENR-EMB Region 02. For the Pathological Septic Vault, well -maintained and ongoing construction of pipe ventilation and additional vault storage was observed. The team recommended that the hospital strengthen its waste management documentation system. For. Celia N. Badua highlighted environmental regulation adherence while marking to urgent process the pending Environmental Certificate Compliance (ECC) to Engr. Arnel P. Noriega. Prior to monitoring, a visit to the Microbiological Water Laboratory took place for potential future collaboration opportunities.

### Summary of Waste Disposal

The weekly summary report highlights the waste generation and disposal activities under Provincial Government Offices and Provincially-Operated Hospitals. Most departments are adhering to waste segregation policies and improved waste management practices. A total of **7,108.73 kilograms** (recyclable, residual, hazardous, and biodegradable) were collected and disposed through the ENRO MRF, Compost Heap and Vermicomposting Facilities, and to the City of Ilagan Sanitary Landfill Facility (SLF).
