### Summary of Waste Disposal

The weekly summary report highlights the waste generation and disposal activities under Provincial Government Offices and Provincially-Operated Hospitals. Most departments are adhering to waste segregation policies and improved waste management practices. A total of **5,393.23 kilograms** (recyclable, residual, hazardous, and biodegradable) were collected and disposed through the ENRO MRF, Compost Heap and Vermicomposting Facilities, and to the City of Ilagan Sanitary Landfill Facility (SLF).
