I. RICE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM	1. Monitored status of farming activities of areas recipient of the seed subsidy under the Early Wet 2014 Rice Production Program . 2. Served as facilitator in the Farmer Led Extensionist (FLE) Rice Techno Demo Field Day at Sta. Maria.
II. CORN DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM A. Production Status	1. Monitored corn planting activity for Wet Cropping Season as of May 19, 2014 that totalled to 9,999.38 hectares for Yellow corn and 1,255.36 hectares for white corn. A total of 11,254.74 hectares area was planted for both yellow and white corn. 2. Gathered terminal harvesting operation posting an average yield of 4.24 mt per hectare for the 138,290.39 hectares of corn for the Dry Season cropping. 3. Served as facilitator in the establishment of 3.0 techno demo for corn production under the project "Sustainable Corn Production in Sloping Area" (SCOPSA) at Sta. Maria, Isabela
