**A. JOB FAIR**

- The Provincial Government of Isabela through the Public Employment Service Office (PESO) conducted a Job Fair for the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2023 entitled: BRO Trabaho para sa mga Isabeleño, with the aim of bringing together various employers and jobseekers to facilitate easy and immediate employment opportunities for our stakeholders.

The aforementioned event was participated by 40 employers and 470 applicants. 103 participants were hired on the spot (21.90%) and 172 near hires or applicant for final assessment

An employment coaching session was also delivered to the jobseekers of the said Job Fair to assist them with their application process as well as for their career endeavor.

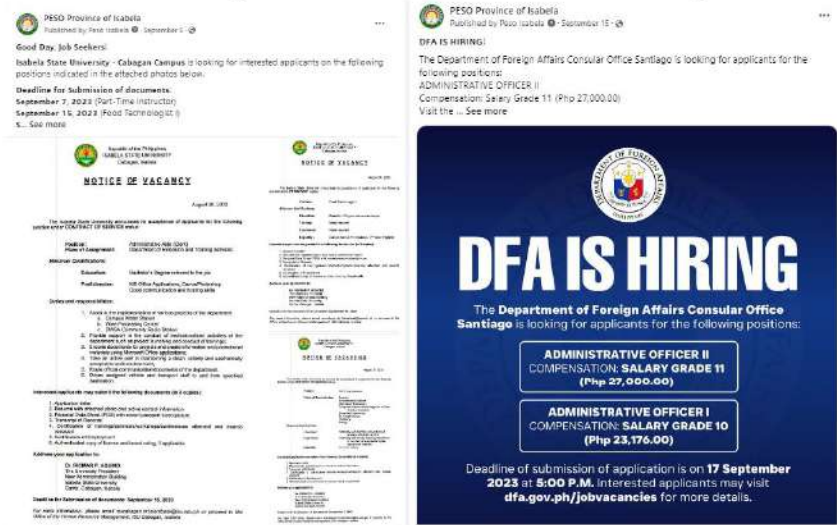
#### **B. JOB FAIR ASSISTANCE**
