The Provincial PESO Manager – Ms. Jeng Reyes served as keynote speaker during the Career Fair Orientation conducted by the HGB College last May 31,

2024, with the theme: "Educating and Connecting the Future of Tomorrow"; which aims to provide the graduating students with valuable insights into the current labor market as they navigate their career journey.

Ms. Reyes provided the participants with LMI such as in-demand jobs and skills, labor market trends, emerging jobs, etc; discussed the First Time Job Seekers Act which aims to waive the fee of the pre-employment government-issued documents for first time jobseekers; and provided students with employment coaching session.
