- The PGI through the PESO provided the walk-in and online applicants with the Labor Market Information by posting the latest labor demands of the various partner employers.
- Provided employers with Labor Supply through referral of interested applicants for their job openings.
- HGB College - Career Fair Orientation

The Provincial PESO Manager – Ms. Jeng Reyes served as keynote speaker during the Career Fair Orientation conducted by the HGB College last May 31,

2024, with the theme: “Educating and Connecting the Future of Tomorrow”; which aims to provide the graduating students with valuable insights into the current labor market as they navigate their career journey.

Ms. Reyes provided the participants with LMI such as in-demand jobs and skills, labor market trends, emerging jobs, etc; discussed the First Time Job Seekers Act which aims to waive the fee of the pre-employment government-issued documents for first time jobseekers; and provided students with employment coaching session.



III. CAREER DEVELOPMENT SUPPORT PROGRAM (CDSP)

- San Manuel, Isabela – Malalinta National High School

The PGI through the Provincial PESO Manager Ms. Jeng Reyes served as resource speaker in the Career Guidance Advocacy Program (CGAP) conducted by Malalinta National High School last April 3, 2024; at the Malalinta Community Center; with the theme: “Paggabay sa Karera: Unang Hakbang Tungo sa Matatag na Kinabukasan” and presented the LMI to the 206 (Grade 9 to Grade 12) participants of the said event.

Ms. Reyes also discussed the First Time Job Seekers Act to the students for them to be informed of its benefits such as free government issued documents for first time jobseekers.

The said discussion was held last April 3, 2024 at the SDO Isabela, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela; attended by the PPESO through PESO Manager Ms. Jeng Reyes and PESO Staff Mr. Giovanni Lumabao together with the Career Guidance Counselors and representatives from SDO Isabela and ISU Ilagan.
