- Core Group Meeting for Assessment Fee Subsidy

In line with the Provincial Government of Isabela (PGI)'s new program: "Competency Assessment of Technical Vocational Livelihood Students and Industry Workers" through the PPESO in partnership with the TESDA and SDO Isabela, which aims to empower the Technical Vocational Students and Industry Workers to be more employable through the NC II by providing them with free assessment fee for their chosen courses, a meeting was conducted prior to the start of its implementation. It was held last January 31, 2024 at the PESO, 2nd floor PWSDO Bldg., Capitol Compound, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela.

The objective of the said meeting is to create a Core Group and discuss the guidelines of the said PGI program. It was attended by the TESDA Provincial Director – Dr. Vilma C. Cabrera, DepEd SDO Isabela Education Program Supervisor – Ms. Larina M. Colobong, DepEd SDO Isabela Chief Education Supervisor – Mr. Jesus D. Antonio, and School Heads from various vocational schools in the province.



- ISU Cauayan System Development Evaluation

Last January 16, 2024, IT students from Isabela State University of Cauayan visited the Provincial PESO for the evaluation of their thesis project – a website for online employment facilitation and job matching as well as to discuss the possibility of deploying their system as an online employment website for the Province of Isabela.

Unfortunately, their system was not yet approved for deployment because of the lacking in terms of features and security. With this, the PESO provided them with specific recommendations for additional features and dashboards which can be used for their system development.
