## I. REFERRAL AND PLACEMENT

# A. <u>EMPLOYMENT-RELATED ASSISTANCE PROVIDED TO LGUS AND OTHER INSTITUTIONS</u>

#### Job Fair Assistance

The PGI through the Provincial PESO assisted the PESOs of the following Local Government Units (LGUs) in the province of Isabela in the conduct of their job fair by inviting Employers and National Government Agencies (NGAs)to participate:

Aside from inviting employers and NGAs for the job fair, Provincial PESO Manager – Ms. Jeng Reyes was also invited by the LGU of Alicia and Luna, Isabela to provide the jobseekers with employment coaching session, to guide them on their career path and job-seeking journey.

- The Provincial Government of Isabela through the Provincial PESO assisted the Overseas Workers Welfare Administration (OWWA) Region 2 in the facilitation of their Balik Pinas Balik Hanapbuhay (BPBH) Program, specifically, in the conduct of their Entrepreneurial Development Training (EDT) for the sixty-five (65) returning OFWs in the Province of Isabela by facilitating the use of the venue and sending additional manpower to assist them in the said event last September 24, 2024; 8:00 AM 4:00 PM; at the Isabela Provincial Training Center (IPTC), Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela.

On the said event, Provincial PESO Manager – Ms. Jeng Reyes also served as resource speaker and presented the services that the participants may avail from the Provincial PESO. She also provided them with Labor Market Information such as the current demands in the Labor Market (job vacancies) based from the submitted data of the PESO's partner employers.
