

<p><u>Infectious Disaster Cluster – Emerging and Re-emerging Diseases</u></p> <p>Conduct of COVID 19 Monitoring and Tracking</p>	<p>To implement T3 Management System – 6 Tier Approach) Prevent, Detect, Isolate, Treat, Reintegrate, and Adapting to “New Normal”(PDITRA)</p> <p>Monitoring and surveillance are intensified thru establishment of border checkpoint located in Cordon, Isabela</p> <p>As part of the province’s local containment strategy, PGI operates several provincial quarantine facilities which caters to returning LSIs and ROFs</p> <p>For effective reporting of COVID 19, a systematic tracking is maintained by the IPHO. Data are primarily collated from daily online reports submitted by C/MLGUs and Quarantine and Isolation Facilities maintained by the PGI</p> <p>To detect, prevent, and isolate potential carriers of COVID 19 from LSIs and ROFs entering the border checkpoint at Cordon, Isabela</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ In collaboration with other government agencies, IPHO deployed teams at the Drop-off point checkpoint and Quarantine Facility located at Punta Amelita Resort, Cordon, Isabela to conduct health monitoring using triage procedures to Locally Stranded Individuals(LSIs), Returning Overseas Filipinos(ROFs) entering the province ❖ Monitored health situations of LSIs and ROFS quarantined at the following Provincial Quarantine Facilities: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ISU Dormitory(Echague) - ISU Presidential Cottage(Echague) - Biazon Hostel(Echague) - Orient Pearl Hotel(Echague) - Zerex Hotel(Cauayan City) - Water World Resort(Ramon, until 8/04/20 only)) ❖ IPHO Tracking Team recorded 276 COVID 19 positive cases in the province for the month ❖ IPHO personnel monitors and updates COVID 19 data using the following tracking systems: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. COVID 19 Cases Tracking 2. Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facility(TTMF) Tracking – Spreadsheet 3. Line List of ROFs and LSIs entering the province via Cordon, Isabela – Recorded a total of 3,194 LSIs(244 Balik Probinsya and 2,950 private), and 5 ROFs 4. Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facility(TTMF) Tracking – DOH Data Collect App(newly introduced by DOH) ❖ Deployed IPHO Medical Technologists at Punta Amelita Resort conducted Rapid Diagnostic Tests(RDT) to 3,541 LSIs and 1,019 ROFs from August 1-27, 2020
