ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT

April to June 2018

Introduction:

The school is known to be a unique institution run by the **Provincial Government of Isabela** which offers programs and services in promotion of the educational development and social welfare of the children with hearing-impairment for the past few decades. Hence, the school continuous to sincerly uphold its mission/vision by providing quality educational services to its clients in all levels. Wherein the school is directly supervised by the **Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office** while it is provisionally adopted by the **San Mariano SPED Center** and **Quezon National High School**.

As of this month of **June 2018**, we were able to accommodate **90 enrollees** from **Kinder** to **Grade 6** for the **Elementary Level** and **Grade 7 – Grade 10** for the **Junior High School Level**. Wherein, **fourteen (14)** of them are from other provinces.

FACILITIES:

With regards to the facilities, there are only **13 double deck beds** available at **Boys' Dormitory** and the same number of beds at **Girls' Dormitory** which supposedly accommodate **26 students for male** and **26 for female**, however, as of the moment, the children in both dorms share the beds at night while we are working out to provide additional of at least **6-double deck beds** for both dorms.

Since the number of students increased from **68** (previous school year) to **90** officially enrolled for this school year, there is a need for us to provide additional of at least **16 arm-chairs**, for the mean time, the children share a table and the others use monoblocks during their clases.

ACTIVITIES:

- At the specific date of **June 8, 2018**, we were able to conduct the **First General Assembly Meeting** facilitated by the undersigned and **Mrs. Gina Rivero-Assistant Head Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office**, Province of Isabela.
- There is a conduct of **sign language training** for the parents every **Friday at noon** before they fetch their children home and it is officially started on **June 22, 2018**.
- For the academic activities, classes were immediately proceeded after the orientation of the children wherein regular classes for both **Elementary and Junior High School** were strictly served base on the class schedules provided for this School Year.
