

On November 21, 2024, an Anti-Tetanus shot was administered to one (1) client at the GFNDY Provincial Hospital due to accidental wound caused by a rusty wire. Medical check-up at the same hospital for a client suffering from dry cough, accompanied by Nurse Calabazon, on November 30, 2024 Close monitoring to residents who had coughs, colds and toothache while regular supervision of HP on their medical intake.
