


This includes two (2) residents in Grades 6 and two (2) in Grade 5, two (2) in Grade 4, two (2) in Grade 3, three (3) in Grade 2, and two (2) in kindergarten while one (1) newly admitted is temporarily enrolled in Grade 4.At present, three (3) residents are enrolled in Alibagu National High School (ANHS). Specifically, there is one resident each in Grades 7, 9, and 10.Psychometrician Villanueva coordinated with Principal Estrellon of AES on February 06, 2025 re: the academic status of one resident.HP Atraje attended the PTCA meeting on February 19, 2025 for the upcoming graduation of two (2) Grade 6 residents at AES.Four (4) residents were awarded with Academic Excellence (With Honors) for the 3rd quarter of school year 2024-2025, with HP Atraje in attendance on February 22, 2025.
