

Activities Undertaken from March 31 – April 4, 2014

- On April 01, 2014 the Federation of Senior Citizen Association of the Phils(FSCAP) Isabela Chapter conducted its the regular meeting attended by Municipal/Chapter Presidents and Provincial Federation Officers held at Senior Citizens Model Day Center, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela. Around sixty-five (65) senior citizens attended the said meeting. The meeting started at 8:00 AM with their regular agenda tackled and ended at 12:30 noon. The elderlies were very much happy with the new audio set and cabinet type air condition unit given by the Provincial Government of Isabela. The FSCAP President, Mr. Republic Madamba said during the meeting that the Provincial Government does not stop from providing the needs of the elderlies particularly for the Senior Citizen officers that delivers convenience and comfort every time they meet among themselves in the Center. He added that the group is one of the priorities of the present administration.
- SWO III Marirose J. Nicasio represented the PSWD Office in the 5th and 6th Farmers Congress in Maconacon and Divilacan, Isabela on April 3 -4, 2014. - On April 4, 2014, SWO III Charmiya Rosalina L. Cruz and DCW II Roger G. One of the agenda that was discussed is the preparation of survey among 3-5 year old children in preparation to the day care service program. Also, they were reminded to prepare for the ECCD center-based accreditation and to coordinate with the PSWD office for technical assistance.
- For the month of March, the PSWD Office under the Aid to Individual in Crisis Situation have extended a total amount of P222,450.00 to 48 families/beneficiaries for medical, transportation, burial assistance and fire victims including 1 family from Caloocan City who is a former resident of Fura, Gamu, Isabela and to the 4 Congressional districts of the province with the following breakdown:
