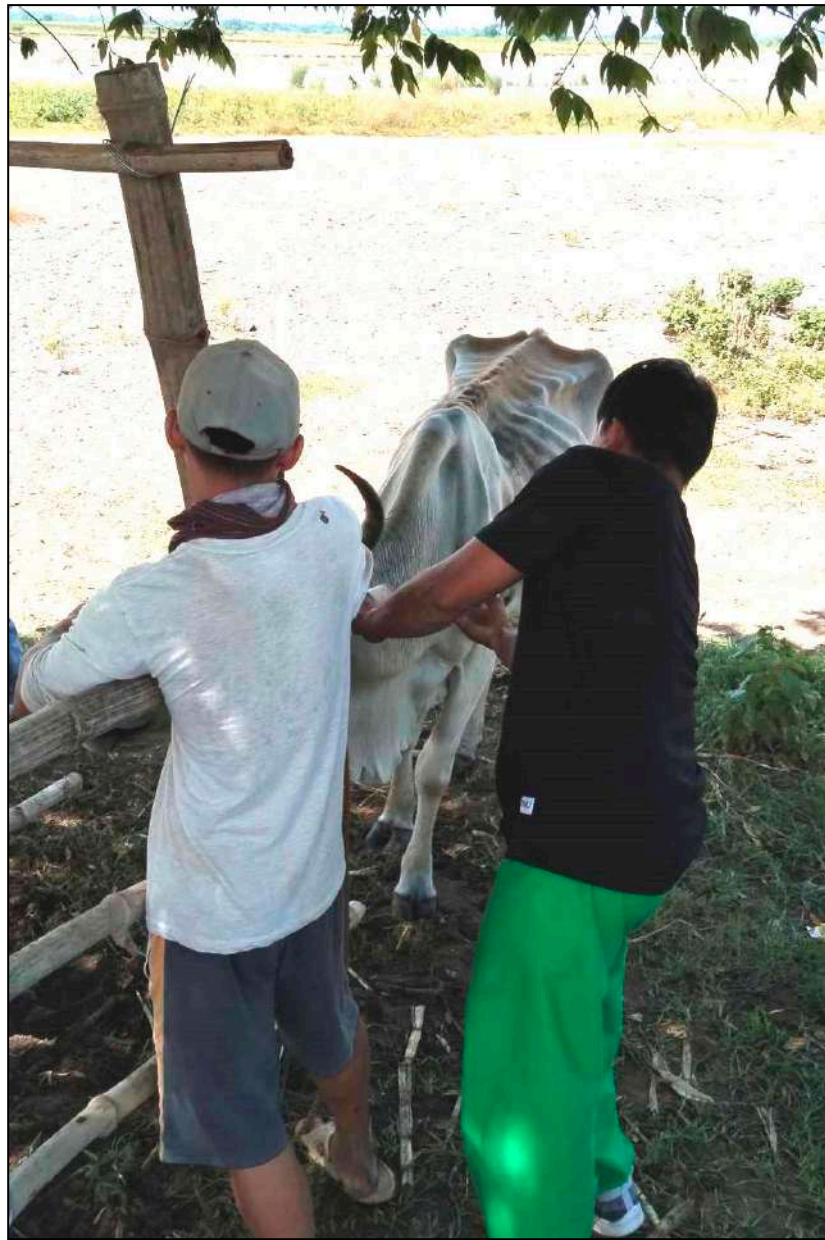

To control dog population, the PVET Technical Staff and the Livestock Technician conduct neutering of dogs in the different municipalities of the province.

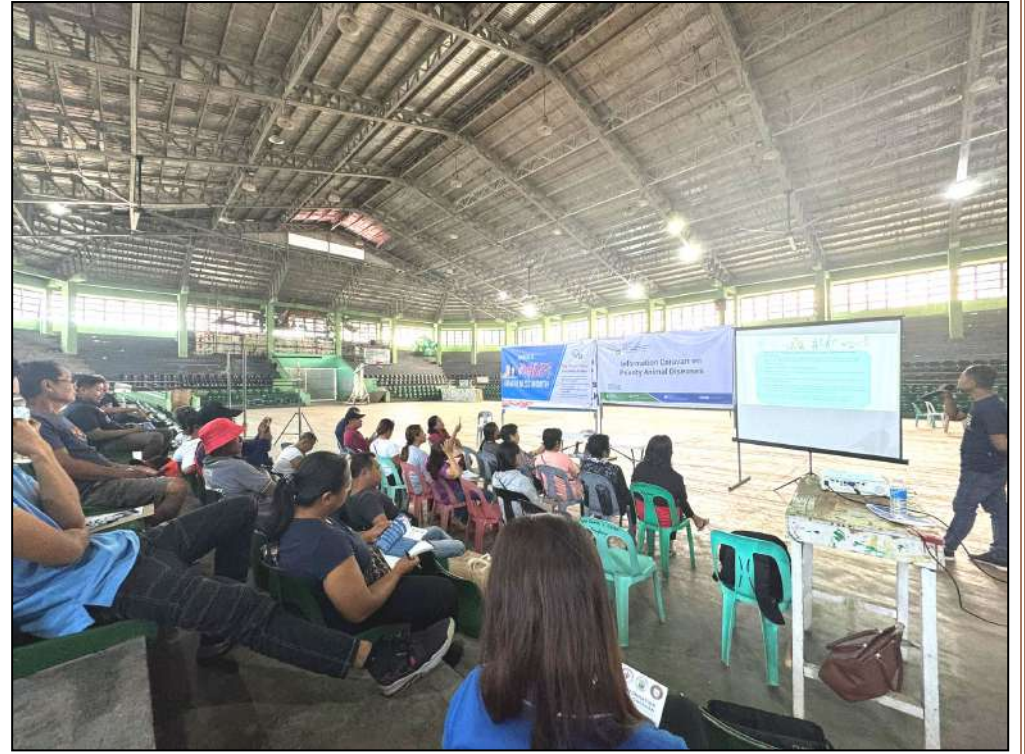

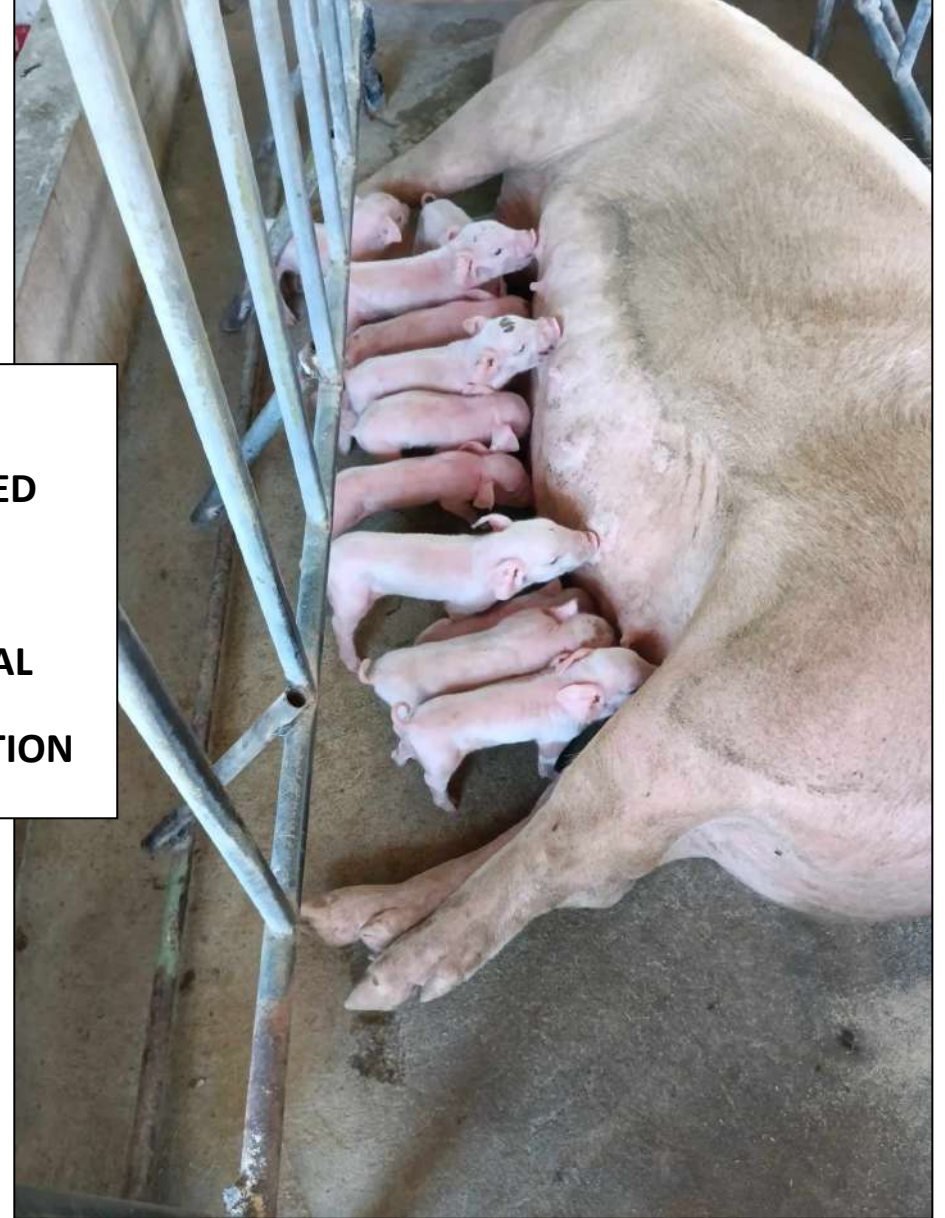

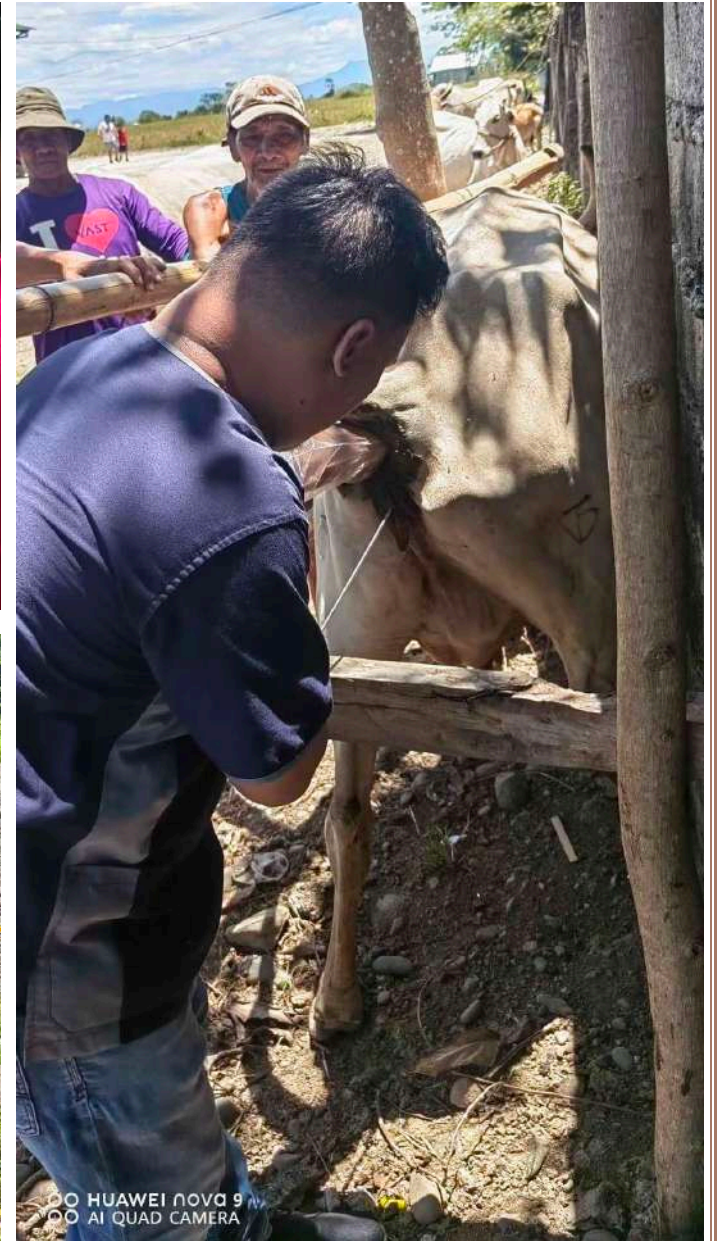

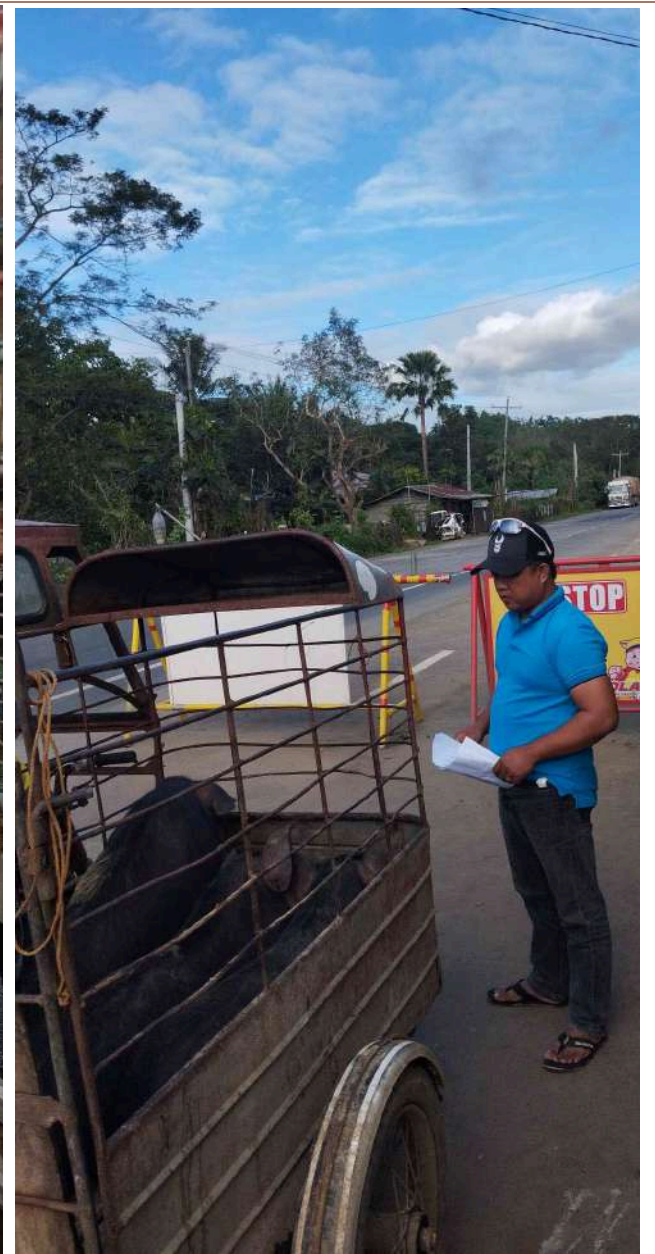
ANIMAL HEALTH QUARANTINE CHECKPOINTS

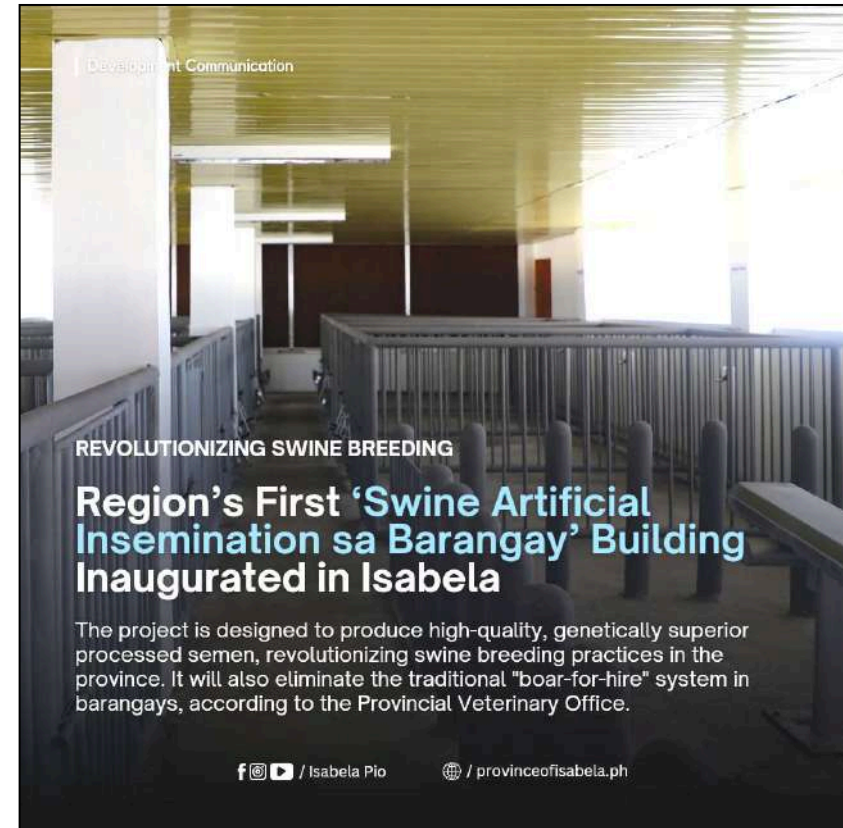
