SIKAD! MULTI-SECTORAL VALIDATION OF LYDP PLANNING AND MONITORING GUIDELINES September 30 – October 1, 2024

The SIKAD! Forum is the culmination of the NAKAKALOCAL and #YouthDevInYourArea series conducted by the National Youth Commission in the 17 different regions of the NAKAKALOKAL #YouthDevInYourArea is an initiative of the NYC to enhance its youth development strategies. Attended bν selected Federation Sangguniang Kabataan Presidents. Local Development Youth Officers, and Local Youth Development Council members across the country, the SIKAD Forum served as the kick-off of the finalization, approval, and implementation of proposed revised guidelines for the the Local Youth Development Plan (LYDP) formulation and LYDP Monitoring and Evaluation by convening Youth Development workers and stakeholders to seek for their perspective and gather their opinion.

Officials of the National Youth Commission. Commissioner Michelle namely. Gonzales, Commissioner Karl Josef Legaspi. and Commissioner Atty. Reena Vivienne Pineda, joined the Forum and the dialogue together with the participants. Ms. Sarah Jean Grutas of the of the Planning, Monitoring, and Evaluation Division (PMED) of the NYC presented the Program Objectives which includes the reporting of the NAKAKALOCAL series key results, the review of the proposed revised LYDP and M&E Guidelines, the concept of the MEAL Plan, presentation of the #YouthDevInYourArea key results, and the introduction the SK-LYDC-LYDO to Functionality Assessment Tool.

Mr. Conrado R. Rigor, Jr. the Assistant Division Chief of PMED, presented the results of the NAKAKALOKAL consultation in the 17 regions of the country followed by the presentation on the proposed revised Local Planning or LYDP Guidelines by Ms. Angelu Marie Villareal

In line with the proposed revised Planning Guidelines, the NYC, through Dr. Bernadette Mariano Fernando, Division Chief of the Policy and Research Division, discussed the proposed amendments to the LYDP Monitoring and Evaluation Guidelines.

For the second half of the first day, Mr. Teodolfo Bonitez of the PME Division discussed the concept of the MEAL Framework in relation to the monitoring of the LYDP. As the final agenda on Day 1, Mr. Rowell B. Velonza, the NYC Statistician, discussed the preliminary results of the #YouthDevInYourArea series or the SGLG – Youth Development Governance Area Rapid Assessment.

After all the discussions for the first day, an open forum was facilitated by the PME Division. Among the issues discussed were the possible indicators for the SGLG and the LYDP Planning, Monitoring, and Evaluation Guidelines.

On the second day, Mr. James Ceasar A. Ventura. a former Commissioner, and now the Division Chief of the Regional Youth Development Division, introduced for the first time, the SK-LYDC-LYDO Functionality Assessment which shall serve as the checklist of duties mandated responsibilities of the Sangguniang Kabataan, Local Youth Development Officers, and the Local Youth Development Council. After which, Dr. Bernadette Fernando presented the synthesis and the ways forward after the SIKAD! Forum.

As part of the travel agenda, Ms. Mamuri-Fatalla also visited the National Youth Commission Central Office in Quezon City to claim the Youth Organization Registration (YORP) Program national certificates of twenty-three (23) newly registered youth and youthserving organizations of the province of Isabela. The certificates were handed over by Ms. Shayne Taay, the NYC YORP Secretariat.


