YOUTH DEVELOPMENT MONITORING ON COMPLIANCE TO RA 10742 AND DILG AND NYC POLICIES FOR THE 1ST QUARTER OF 2025	The Provincial Youth Development Office, in its mandate to provide technical assistance to Local Youth Development Officers and Sangguniang Kabataan Officials, took the initiative to monitor the status of Youth Development work in the province of Isabela through the Local Government Unit's compliance to Republic Act 10742 or the SK Reform Act of 2015, as amended by RA 11768. The monitoring aims to gauge the concerns of the LYDOs and the SKs and to plan what interventions from the PYDO should be prioritized. Moreover, this aims to help the National Youth Commission in their own monitoring activities and confirm the accuracy of the reports from the national office. The provincial government, through the PYDO, specifically monitors the compliance of LGUs, through their LYDOs and SKs to the following: 1. Status of appointment of the Local Youth Development Councils; 3. Number of YORP-Registered Youth and Youth-Serving Organizations; 4. Status of approval of the Local Youth Development Plans; 5. Status of account creation to the SK Learning Management System; 6. Number of Quarterly Meetings conducted through the submission of the approved Minutes of the Meeting; and, 7. Submission of the Monitoring and Evaluation reports for the implementation of the Local Youth Development Plans.	As profiled and monitored by the Office for the 1st quarter of 2025, the following information are reported: 1. 12 out of 37 Local Youth Development Officers are appointed, the rest are designated; 2. 36 out of 37 Local Government Units have convened their Local Youth Development Council; 3. Among the 37 LGUs, Santiago City has the most number of registered organizations, followed by Cauayan City. PARTICIPATION IN THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN REGIONAL TASK FORCE (SK-RTF) AND PHILIPPINE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PLAN REGIONAL INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE (PYDP-RIAC) 2ND QUARTER MEETING May 20 & 21, 2025.0

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The National Youth Commission, in its thrust to convene regional bodies to coordinate efforts among agencies and youth development workers, and to address pressing issues concerning the youth through identifying gaps implementation of relevant youthrelated laws and policies, redefined the functions and goals of the then PYDP Regional Task Force (PYDP-RTF) and the Regional Interagency Committee on Youth Development (RIACYD).

The former PYDP RTF has now been named SK-RTF which handles the institutional and administrative matters related to Republic Act 10742 and other relevant laws while the former RIACYD is now called PYDP-RIAC which shall facilitate cross-sectoral collaboration and support the implementation of Youth Development Plans.

The NYC through its Pampanga Area Office called for the convening of the FY 2025 2nd Quarter Meeting of the SK-RTF and the PYDP-RIAC

STATUS/REMARKS/ ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The provincial government, through the SK Provincial Federation President, Hon. Catherine Joy A. Legaspi, together with OIC-PYDO Mr. Adrian Philip Baysac, Ms. Stephanie Mamuri-Fatalla, and Ms. Jovella Lelina of PYDO, joined the meeting and delivered insights on matters concerning the Sangguniang Kabataan and the youth development work in the region.

Among the agenda discussed in both bodies were: (1) Presentation of NYC revised guidelines on Convening the SK RTF and the PYDP RIAC; (2) NYC Policy and Research Division Policy Brief on Key Youth Issues under the Philippine Youth Development Plan centers of participation; (3) Cross sectoral collaboration opportunities; (4) Updates on the SK Web Portal and last May 20 and 21 at the Quirino Watersports Complex, Cabarroguis, Quirino. The meeting was attended by the SK Federation Presidents and Local Youth Development Officers of Batanes, Cagayan, Isabela, Nueva Vizcaya, Quirino, and the City of Santiago.

PYDP-RIAC During the Meeting. the Citv Government of Santiago and the Provincial Government of Isabela shared its best practices and initiatives on Youth Development highlighting the support local and provincial leaders to elevate the vouth development work and services the entire province.

The PYDO underscored the efforts of the provincial government to strengthen youth volunteerism and active youth participation in the province through enabling policies and activities for the Kabataang Isabeleños while in the constant pursuit of efficiently addressing youth concerns.

As agreed by the body, the Province of Isabela will be hosting the FY 2025 3rd Quarter Meeting of the SK-RTF and PYDP-RIAC on July 2025.
