Once registered under the YORP, the Provincial Youth Development Office, through the PYDO Focal Person on YORP, uploads the required documents of the Youth and Youth-Serving Organizations to the NYC YORP Hub for verification. After which, verified Organizations are given a Unique Registration Number as their identification to the NYC's database of YOs and YSOs. Organizations need to renew their registration every three years and shall submit an accomplishment report annually. updated and most comprehensive guidelines on the appropriation, release, planning, and budgeting process in the utilization of the 10% SK Funds in the barangay. Through the said orientation, participating SK officials and LYDOs were equipped with budgeting and planning knowledge and skills relevant in the performance of their youth development roles in their communities.

Gearing towards this year's Buwan ng Kabataan and International Youth Day celebrations, Stephanie Joy Fatalla of the PYDO, led the consultation on the proposed activities for the said celebration. Youth leaderparticipants actively participated in said consultation by proposing various activities promoting meaningful engagement of the youth this August.

Newly assigned OIC-PYDO and BRO-Ed Coordinator Mr. Adrian Philip S. Baysac, discussed the scholarship profiling and proposed youth and scholarship caravan highlighting the instruction of Governor Rodito T. Albano, III of improving and streamlining the implementation of the provincial scholarship program to primarily cater the educational needs of the marginalized and indigent students in the province. This was followed by the presentation of the BRO-Ed Application Web Portal by Mr. Fokker V. Espiritu of the PYDO.

Mr. Rey Mel Resposo reported the performance and compliance of component LGUs through their SK Federation Presidents and LYDOs Quarter 2nd the Youth **Profiling** Development and Monitoring underscoring transparency and accountability in promoting youth development and participation in the local level.
