ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT FOR JUNE 2025

Echague District Hospital, formerly Primo Gaffud District Hospital, began in 1974 as a 10-bed facility in San Fabian, Echague, Isabela. In May 2005, it was relocated to Ipil, Echague, and officially renamed by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan on September 13, 2005.

It now serves as a core referral hospital for southern Isabela, covering about 300,000 people from several municipalities. Patients also come from nearby towns and even from the provinces of Quirino and Ifugao.
