I am pleased to report that, based on a statement submitted by the Isabela Police Provincial Office, the number of road crashes in the Province involving *all types of vehicles* went down by 663 from 1,886 in 2018 to 1,223 in 2019 or a **35.15% reduction**; and down by 1,550 from 2393 in 2016 when iSMART started operating or a **55.89% reduction**.

The number of road crashes involving *motorcycles* went down by 175 from 1077 in 2018 to 902 in 2019 or a **16.25% reduction**; and down by 1,418 from 2,320 in 2016 when iSMART started operating or a **61.12% reduction**.

A copy of the above-cited IPPO statement is attached as Annex A; and a data analysis as Annex B.

The numbers, however, are still too high and, with your guidance and support, this Office will work harder to bring the incidence of road crashes in the Province down to a negligible level and keep it there.
