### EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 05 Series of 2022

#### DECLARING THE 11th OF MAY 2022, WEDNESDAY, AS A SPECIAL NON-WORKING DAY IN THE PROVINCE OF ISABELA, IN COMMEMORATION OF THE 166th FOUNDATION ANNIVERSARY OF THE PROVINCE

**Whereas**, it is the policy of the State to ensure that Filipino heritage and culture are cultivated, promoted and sustained;

**Whereas**, President Joseph Ejercito Estrada issued Presidential Proclamation 108 on 10 May 1999 declaring May 11<sup>th</sup> of every year a Special Day in the province of Isabela, to give the people full opportunity to celebrate the milestone in their history;

**Whereas**, the Provincial Government of Isabela encourages the public and private sectors to contribute in the implementation of its policy to appreciate, promote, and celebrate Isabela's cultural heritage, to deepen the young generation's affection for local culture and history, and afford families the opportunity to get together and participate in commemorative activities;

**Whereas**, the Province of Isabela has a well-established annual tradition of celebrating the Foundation Anniversary of the province and encouraging the public and private sector to participate in or witness the activities conducted during the celebration;

**Whereas**, for the year 2022, the Provincial Government of Isabela is celebrating the event by holding a Thanksgiving Mass at 7:00 a.m. of 11 May 2022 at the Queen Isabela Park Open Amphitheatre in the City of Ilagan;

**NOW, THEREFORE I, RODOLFO T. ALBANO III**, Governor of the Province of Isabela, pursuant to *Presidential Proclamation No. 108* issued on 09 May 1999, do hereby declare the 11th of May 2022, Wednesday, as a Special Non-Working Day in the Province of Isabela, in celebration of the 166th Foundation Anniversary of the province.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
