EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. <u>24</u> Series of 2024

RECONSTITUTING THE PROVINCIAL COMMUNITY-BASED MONITORING SYSTEM (CBMS) COORDINATING BOARD IN THE PROVINCE OF ISABELA

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) No. 11315 otherwise known as Community-Based Monitoring System Act (CBMS Act) was enacted on 17 April 2019, institutionalizing the conduct of the CBMS in every city and municipality in the country;

WHEREAS, the CBMS is an organized technology-based system of collecting, processing, and validating necessary disaggregated data that may be used for planning, program implementation, and impact monitoring at the local level while empowering communities to participate in the process;

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the said Act states that each city and municipality is the primary data-collecting authority within its locality;

WHEREAS, Section 6 of the same Act states that the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) shall serve as the lead agency in the implementation of the CBMS, and shall monitor the data collection by cities and municipalities to ensure adherence to official concepts, definitions, and standards of poverty statistics;

WHEREAS, Section 14 of the Act provides for the creation of the CBMS Council composed of the PSA, Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), and Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT), to be headed by the PSA, for purposes of achieving secure and efficient data sharing arrangements between and among concerned cities and municipalities and national government agencies to be used for their particular social protection and welfare programs and projects;

WHEREAS, the CBMS Council approves Resolution No. 06, Series of 2021 on the establishment of the Provincial and City/Municipal Coordinating Board that will be responsible for overseeing the CBMS operations in their respective locality, ensuring logistic and other requirements are in place prior and during the CBMS operations, and resolving issues and concerns encountered in the conduct of CBMS in their jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the CBMS Council decided to revise the composition of the Provincial and City/Municipal Coordinating Boards for a more efficient and effective disposition of the functions through Resolution No. 01, Series of 2022;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Information Agency – Isabela is included as a board member in order to assist the CBMS Coordinating Board in the province in its campaigns and advocacy during the conduct of the CBMS;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Statistics Committee (PSC) – Isabela, which has been established by virtue of Executive Order No. 22, s. 2018 to serve as the highest policy making body on statistical matters in the province, passed PSC-Isabela Resolution No. 17, Series of 2023 "Requesting the Provincial Government of Isabela to Amend Executive Order No. 03, Series of 2022 to Reconstitute the Provincial Community-Based Monitoring System Coordinating Board in the Province of Isabela";

NOW THEREFORE, I, HON. RODOLFO T. ALBANO III, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law as Governor of the Province of Isabela, hereby decree the following:

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION OF THE PROVINCIAL CBMS COORDINATING BOARD.

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS OF THE PROVINCIAL CBMS COORDINATING BOARD. The Provincial CBMS Coordinating Board (PCCB) shall perform the following functions:

- Oversee the implementation of the CBMS operations in the province. Report status to the concerned Regional Statistical Committee (RSC) through the Regional CBMS Coordinating Board (RCCB) pursuant to CBMS Council Resolution No. 02, Series of 2022.
- Resolve issues and concerns encountered in the conduct of CBMS. For issues that cannot be resolved at the provincial level, escalate to the concerned PSA Regional Statistical Services Offices and RSCs through the RCCBs.
- 3. Issue communications, directives, instructions, and/or circulars to cooperate, mobilize, and provide support/assistance to the CBMS operations in areas but not limited to the conduct/provision of the following:
 - a. Active participation in coordination meetings and activities;
 - b. Publicity and information campaign for the conduct of CBMS;
 - Venue for the training conduct, headquarters for the enumeration personnel, and machine processing;
 - Transportation facilities for the enumeration personnel, and transport of CBMS forms, supplies, and materials;
 - e. Communication and wireless Internet connection facility;
 - f. Storage area for tablets, forms, and other materials;
 - g. Health and legal services to CBMS personnel; and
 - h. Facilitation of enumeration in government-owned and private institutions, and other hard-to-reach areas.
- 4. Take up other matters as necessary for the successful conduct of the CBMS.

SECTION 3. REPEALING CAUSE. All Executive Orders or issuances inconsistent with the provisions of this order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect immediately and let copies hereof be provided to all concerned for their information, reference, and guidance.
