Simultaneously, the government fulfilled its obligations responsibly, with a total expenditure amounting to Php3,972,132,824.95, reflecting the conscientious allocation of resources towards essential services and development priorities.

This judicious financial stewardship culminated in the identification of savings amounting to Php167,226,837.91. These savings signify the surplus funds resulting from efficient expenditure management and the prudent execution of budgetary allocations. Recognizing the importance of these savings in furthering the province's developmental objectives, the Provincial Government, through the Office of the Governor, seeks to declare these funds as savings to be utilized in augmenting the resources allocated to various vital programs, projects, and activities.

It is imperative to underscore that the availability of these savings underscores the Provincial Government's unwavering commitment to fiscal prudence and accountability. By maximizing the utilization of available resources, the Provincial Government endeavors to enhance service delivery, foster economic development, and improve the overall well-being of Isabeleños.

In line with the principles of transparency, accountability, and good governance, the proposed ordinance seeks to formalize the declaration of savings and outline the mechanisms for their utilization. Section 5. Adherence to Relevant Laws. The reprogramming, augmentation, utilization, or disbursement of funds made pursuant to this Ordinance shall be subject to existing relevant government budgeting, accounting, and auditing laws, rules, regulations, and issuances.

Section 6. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
