**WHEREAS,** it is the policy of the Provincial Government of Isabela (PGI) to promote the health, and welfare of the Isabeleños;

WHEREAS, the Universal Health Care Act or R.A. No. 11223 provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of all Filipinos and instill health and consciousness among them by providing Filipinos access to comprehensive set of quality and cost-effective, promotive preventive, curative, rehabilitative and palliative health services without causing financial hardships, and prioritizes the needs od the population who cannot afford such services:

WHEREAS, cervical cancer remains a significant public health threat in the Philippines, being the second most common cancer among women of reproductive age (15-44 years) worldwide which underscores the urgency of implementing a comprehensive, province-wide effort for its elimination;

(Strengthening HPV Immunization towards Elimination and Leadership Development) Against Cervical Cancer Program, ensuring that no woman is left behind in the fight against cervical cancer, and maximizing the program's impact at the grassroots level;

WHEREAS, the LGUs, being at the forefront of local governance and public health, are uniquely positioned to implement community-based strategies that promote HPV vaccination, increase the uptake of cervical cancer screening, and facilitate public awareness campaigns to educate communities about cervical cancer prevention, risk factors, and treatment options;

WHEREAS, sustained collaboration and resource-sharing among the LGUs, the DOH, and other stakeholders are essential to achieving the desired outcome of reducing cervical cancer cases to zero, aligning with the global and national targets for cervical cancer elimination by 2030;

WHEREAS, the active involvement of LGUs will help identify and overcome local barriers to vaccination and screening, such as logistical challenges, misinformation, cultural attitudes, and financial constraints, thereby enhancing the overall effectiveness of the program;

WHEREFORE, premises considered, upon motion of the Honorable Emmanuel Joselito B. Añes, duly approved and seconded in a session duly assembled, it was –
