A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PROVINCIAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 04-2024 RECOMMENDING THAT THE ENTIRE PROVINCE OF ISABELA BE PLACED UNDER A STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO EXTENSIVE DAMAGE TO LIVES, LIVELIHOODS, AND AGRICULTURE CAUSED BY RECENT SUCCESSIVE WEATHER DISTURBANCES, THEREBY DECLARING FOR THIS PURPOSE A STATE OF CALAMITY OVER THE ENTIRE PROVINCE OF ISABELA

WHEREAS, the Province of Isabela has been severely affected by six strong tropical typhoons, all of which passed through the province between October 24, 2024, and November 18, 2024, resulting in extensive destruction across the province

WHEREAS, the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (PDRRMC) has conducted a thorough damage assessment and needs analysis, as required by the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 10121;

WHEREAS, the PDRRMC determined that approximately 450,000 Isabeleños were affected, with damage impacting 34 municipalities and 2 cities, and that more than 30% of those whose livelihoods depend on agriculture suffered significant losses;

WHEREAS, the PDRRMC convened on November 27, 2024, to assess the damage caused by these weather disturbances and subsequently issued PDRRMC Resolution No. 04-2024, recommending to this August Body that the entire province be placed under a state of calamity;

WHEREAS, under Section 16 of Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, local government units are mandated to address the adverse effects of disasters and calamities to protect lives, properties, and livelihoods;

WHEREAS, National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) Memorandum Order No. 60, series of 2019 has established the Revised Guidelines for the Declaration of a State of Calamity;

WHEREAS, the current situation in the Province of Isabela meets the criteria set forth by NDRRMC Memorandum Order No. 60, series of 2019, thereby necessitating the declaration of a state of calamity to facilitate immediate relief, recovery, and rehabilitation efforts;

WHEREAS, the declaration of a state of calamity will enable the Provincial Government of Isabela to access emergency funds, implement necessary interventions, and expedite the recovery and rehabilitation of affected sectors;

WHEREFORE, upon the motion of the Honorable Edward S. Isidro, duly approved and seconded in a session duly assembled, it was -

RESOLVED, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVES, TO PASS A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PROVINCIAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 04-2024 RECOMMENDING THAT THE ENTIRE PROVINCE OF ISABELA BE PLACED UNDER A STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO EXTENSIVE DAMAGE TO LIVES, LIVELIHOODS, AND AGRICULTURE CAUSED BY RECENT SUCCESSIVE WEATHER DISTURBANCES, THEREBY DECLARING FOR THIS PURPOSE A STATE OF CALAMITY OVER THE ENTIRE PROVINCE OF ISABELA.
