WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Isabela has consistently promoted gender equality and empowerment, particularly in rural areas, by enhancing women's participation in socio-economic development;

WHEREAS, women play a crucial role in agriculture and community development as primary caretakers and managers of household resources, significantly contributing to food security and economic stability;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Agriculture Office has been tasked with implementing various programs and projects aimed at improving the livelihoods of farmers and fisherfolk;

WHEREAS, expressing support for PAFC Isabela Resolution No. 3, Series of 2024 strengthens the Provincial Government's commitment to inclusive and gender-responsive development, ensuring that women in agriculture and fisheries are given equal opportunities to access resources, enhance productivity, and achieve economic empowerment, thereby contributing to the overall growth and resilience of the province's agricultural sector;

WHEREAS, to advance the objective of the PAFC resolution, the Provincial Agriculture Office is encouraged to take proactive steps in advancing gender-responsive agricultural development by developing criteria to identify and assess women-led or dominated organizations eligible for livelihood assistance, allocating a specific percentage of livelihood assistance funds to support initiatives led by these organizations, provide capacity-building programs tailored to enhance their skills in resource management, project implementation, and sustainability practices, and foster partnerships with local, national, and international organizations to secure additional resources and support for women-led initiatives, ensuring their meaningful participation in the agricultural sector;

WHEREFORE, upon motion of the Honorable Amador A. Gaffud Jr., duly approved and seconded in a session duly approved, it was –
